

Positive quadratic differential forms: a topological equivalence through Newton polyhedra

In this work we deal with special classes of differential forms in dimension two. We present a geometric method for studying positive quadratic differential forms which consists of an efficient mechanism for describing the local behavior of such systems. The purpose here is to establish conditions under which a positive quadratic differential form is topologically equivalent to its principal form defined by Newton Polyhedra.
